Dear Mr. Wallace:

We have tabulated bids received on December 16, 2025, for the referenced project. Attached herewith is a copy of the bid tabulation. Our estimate for this project (without construction contingencies) was \$3,465,000.00.

The lowest responsive, responsible bidder is Don M. Barron Contractor, Inc. of Farmerville, Louisiana in the amount of \$3,481,800.00. This bid is very close to our estimate. It is our recommendation that the Notice of Award be issued to Don M. Barron Contractor, Inc. in the amount of their low bid subject to concurrence of award by Facility Planning and Control.

Please note that FP&C shows State funds available for construction as \$3,216,380.00. Based on the current bid amount, the City will need to contribute \$265,420 towards construction. Additionally, we recommend the City begin the construction phase of the project with budgeted contingencies. Our opinion of probable cost of July 30, 2025, estimated a construction cost of \$3,811,500 and included a 10% contingency line item. At that time, the City agreed to proceed with the project and cover the required estimated balance of \$595,120. Using the City's same budgeted amount of \$595,120, this leaves \$329,700 for contingencies or about 9.5%.

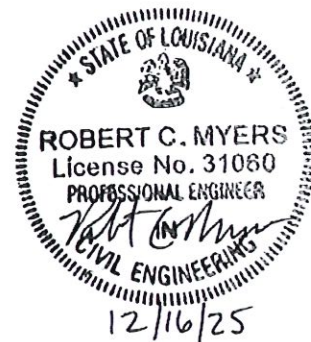
